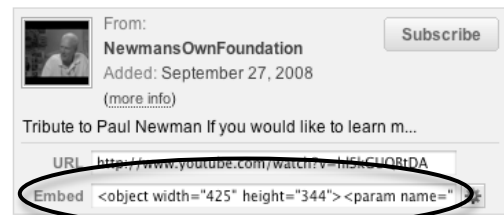


Embedding web content into Concourse

A two-step process for creating a page that displays content from a web application.

I. Get “embed” code from a web site

- 1) Locate content you want to share. Be sure it is freely available and not restricted by login.
- 2) Find and copy the “embed” code. Here are some examples of where to look:
 - YouTube – on the right side of the video page, look for “embed”
 - Flickr – on the right side of the photo page, click “share this”
 - SlideShare – on the right side of the slideshow page, look for “embed”
 - Google Calendar – below the list of calendars on the left side, click “Settings,” then click the name of the calendar and look for “Embed this calendar”
 - Google Map – above the top right corner of the map, click “link”
 - del.icio.us – see <http://delicious.com/help/linkrolls/>



II. Paste the code into a new page in Concourse

- 1) In Concourse, click the “Build” tab and navigate to where you want the content
- 2) Click “Add File” and choose “Create File”
- 3) Click “Use HTML” and paste the web site “embed” code into the “Content” box
- 4) Click “Save”
