### Delicious – why?

- Save and organize bookmarks/favorites
- It's not tied to a computer or browser – even works on an iPhone!
- It's ubiquitous – lots of people use it
- It's easy to use and it's free

### Steps

1. Set up an account – go to <http://del.icio.us> [<http://delicious.com>]
2. Install a browser add-on – “Tag” button
3. Add sites to your list
4. Add tags – they help you find things later, like folders
  - Folksonomy – make your own tags
  - Tag roll - <http://delicious.com/help/tagrolls>
  - Tag cloud - <http://www.wordle.net/create>
5. View your bookmarks as a web page or using the browser add-on
6. Social aspects
  - Share with specific people
  - “Popular” - see what others are bookmarking
  - Collaborate with others to build link lists
  - A badge on your website makes it easy for people to bookmark you
